SAFETY NOTICE

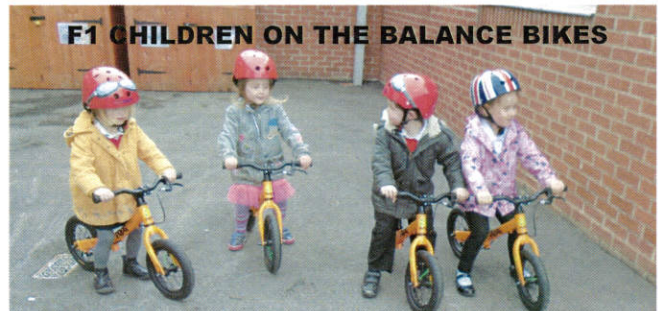
Please do not park in front of the school gates at the beginning and end of the school day. Thank you for your co-operation.
