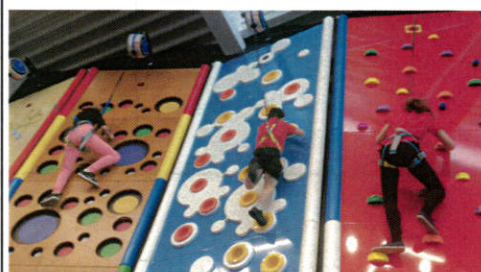
ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A PARENT GOVERNOR?

FIVER CHALLENGE

Year 6 children will be participating in the Fiver Challenge, setting up a mini business and creating products or services that they can then sell/deliver at a profit and engage with their local community. The competition will take place from 06 June to 01 July 2016.
