11 children wrote stories and received a pen for their 500 words.

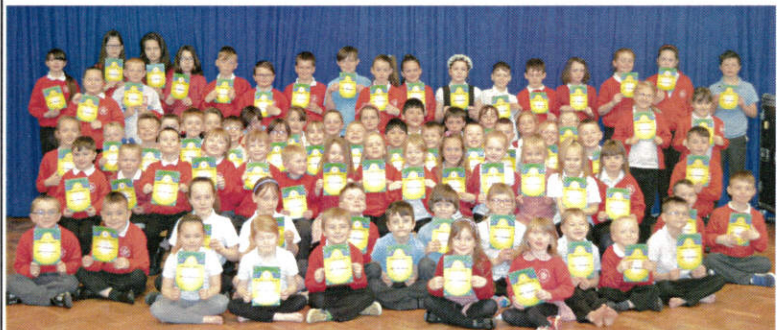
33 parents joined in the Easter fun in Foundation 1 & 2
