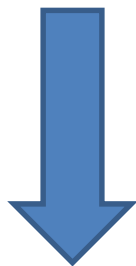
8th January 2014



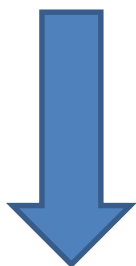
Successful candidates will then be invited to an event on the evening of 8th January 2014, at Molescroft Primary School, HU17 7HF.

At this event all schools offering places will meet all of the successful candidates so far. Candidates will complete a 'school preference' document as a result of the evening where they can record their top 3 choices of a host school for the training.

By 27th January 2014



Successful candidates from the evening event will be invited for a formal interview at Molescroft Primary School or at one of our alliance schools.

This will be a half day event in school. During the half day candidates will spend time in a classroom supporting pupils, have a formal interview, and lead a small group activity with selected children.

Successful candidates will be offered a School Direct training only place through Riding Forward Teaching School (lead School Molescroft Primary) in partnership with the University of Hull.

They will be informed of the host school in which they will be based, starting in September 2014.

Where possible we will try to match successful candidates with one of their choices of host schools.

All offers of a place will be conditional on candidates securing their degree classification (where applicable), completing the professional skills tests, and completion of clearance from the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS).
